How to Attract New Members

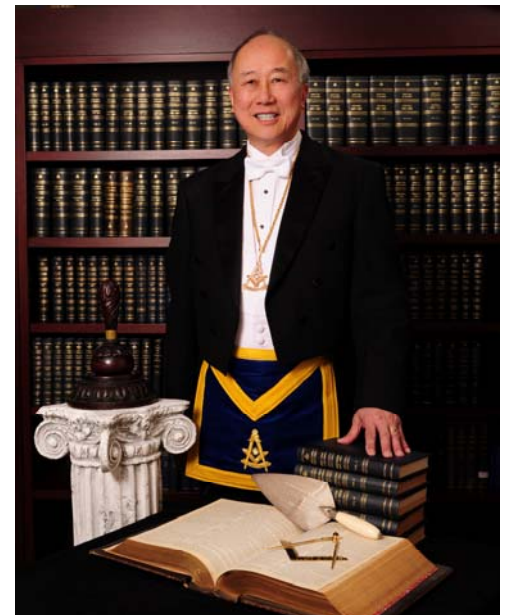
