A New Shrine Hospital !

A long-awaited announcement was just made by the Shrine Hospital Board of Governors that plans are now moving forward for a new Shrine first-class Medical Center to replace the present Geneva Street facility in Los Angeles. It will partner with another renowned healthcare provider, the Huntington Hospital, at property recently purchased in Pasadena next to the Huntington Hospital. Services will be mutually shared between the two healthcare providers, with the ability to support a much-expanded service delivery system for the care of children in the southwest U.S. and Mexico. It will include 75,000 square feet of space for its clinical, surgical, rehabilitation and administrative areas, including a large underground parking facility. Conceptual plans have been submitted to the City of Pasadena for its review and comment. Board Chairman (and PGM) Larry Adamson has commented that, "we hope to complete construction and open the new Medical Center before the end of 2016." He also indicated that a much needed capital campaign will kick off shortly."
